The GTIO is a liaison office promoting trade and commerce between USA and Ghana based companies and facilitates project funding for infrastructure, humanitarian, and economic development projects and programs.

Dr. McKinney is contracted to represent the Project Development International Funding Process, where she manages the business affairs of the "Africa Desk", established to address infrastructure, sustainable, and humanitarian projects in Africa.
